Namaha is a Sanskrit term; literal translation of namaha is "not mine," derived from the Sanskrit negation na, paired with ma, meaning "mine". "Namaha can be affixed to Sanskrit mantras as a means of expressing total dedication. As such, it is a means of reflecting the notion that one's life is in the hands of the universe.

Translation

Salutations to the Goddess who resides in all beings in the form of: {wisdom, light, abundance etc}.

To that constant, eternal presence, I gratefully offer myself again and again.

The feminine energy or nature resides in all beings (RupenaSansthita).

As the flow of life, she is expressed in us as wisdom (Buddhi), sleep (Nidra), the shadow (Chaiya), misunderstanding (Bhranti), peace (Shantih), contentment (Tushti), abundance (Lakshmi), Matri (Mother), Daya (Compassion, Kanti (Radiance) and Shakti (primal Source Energy).
